TOPIC: **Police Response to High Risk Individuals**

DATE: 13 April 2004

PREAMBLE:

It is the policy of the North Bay Police Services Board with respect to high risk individuals that:

The Chief of Police will:

- a. Work, in partnership, where possible, with the local Crown, appropriate members and agencies, including health care providers, government agencies, municipal officials, other criminal justice agencies including law enforcement agencies, as well as victim services to ensure a coordinated and effective strategy in response to high risk individuals that addresses:
 - (i) Bail opposition consistent with the Ministry's guideline on Bail and Violent Crime;
 - (ii) Dangerous offender and long term offender applications;
 - (iii) High Risk Offender National Flagging System and requirements of CPIC;
 - (iv) Information sharing;
 - (v) Case management planning;
 - (vi) Judicial restraint orders;
 - (vii) Victim assistance; and
 - (viii) Disclosure of information, including community notification and safety planning; and

- b. ensure that the police service's skills development and learning plan addresses the training and sharing of information with officers, communicators /dispatchers and supervisors on the police response to high risk individuals.
