A. Mandate of the Unit

Identify criteria offences and timely submit information to the Provincial ViCLAS Centre utilizing the ViCLAS booklet in compliance with Ontario Regulation 550/96.

B. Executive Summary

For the reporting year of January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008 a total of 61 ViCLAS booklets were submitted to the Provincial ViCLAS Centre for analysis. 56 Sexual Assault booklets were submitted along with 1 Child Luring, 2 Child Pornography and 2 supplementary/information booklets.

During this period 86 Criteria Offences were reported and identified by the ViCLAS Coordinator. Of the 86 offences, 82 were for Sexual Assault, 1 Child Luring and 3 Child Pornography. 20 Sexual Assaults and 1 Child Pornography were deemed to be unfounded and 5 Sexual Assaults were classified as assist other department. 1 Sexual Assault was submitted by the OPP prior to the matter being properly identified as occurring in the North Bay Police Service jurisdiction.

Statistically, the number of reported Criteria Offences and the number of submitted booklets is almost identical to 2007 but down compared to 2006. In 2007 there were 83 Criteria Offences identified and 59 booklets submitted. In 2006 there were 118 reported incidents with 87 mandatory submissions and 9 information/supplementary booklets handed in.
