

**NORTH BAY POLICE SERVICES BOARD
BY-LAW 07/2000**

POLICING OF PUBLIC EVENTS

Resolution #94/92 is cancelled and the following enacted.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to establish a policy for the policing of public events by the North Bay Police Service,

The North Bay Police Services Board hereby enacts as follows.

(Application)

1. This By-Law relates to the provision of policing services at public events by the North Bay Police Service.

(Policy)

2. It is the policy of this Board that the provision of policing services at public events shall be the responsibility of the sponsoring organization, subject to the criteria established by the Chief of Police.

(Definitions)

3. For the purposes of this By-Law,
 - (a) **Public Event** shall mean any event where the public has access and the sponsoring organization charges an admission fee.

(Responsibilities of Chief)

4. The Chief of Police will ensure that the costs associated to the policing of Public Events will be borne by the sponsoring organization, subject to the exceptions in Article 5.
5. The Chief of Police may provide policing services, in whole or part, to the sponsoring organization at no cost or for a proportion thereof upon consideration of the following factors:
 - a. Notwithstanding the charging of an admission fee, the event is so public as to positively impact the community;
 - b. The specialized nature of the police services;
 - c. The nature of the sponsoring organization (non profit, service club, etc);
 - d. The extra costs incurred as a result of the event;
 - e. The nature of the event (Liquor License Act applicability, venue, etc).

(To Take Effect)

6. The provisions of this By-Law are effective as of

READ a 1st time this 12th day of September, 2000.

READ a 2nd time this 12th day of September, 2000.

READ a 3rd time and ENACTED AND PASSED this 12th day of September, 2000.
